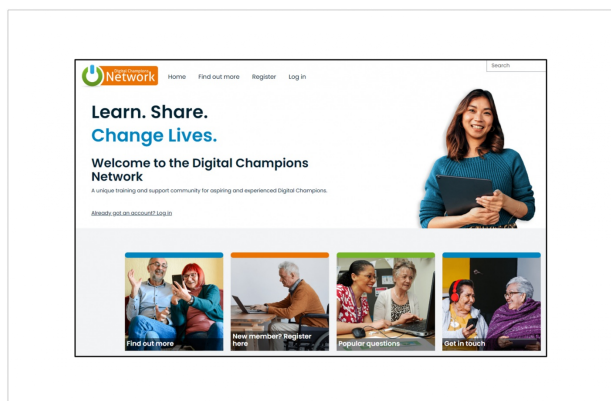


Our Digital Champions Network just got even better!
