Some top ways to save money online

1. Switching suppliers. This includes utilities such as electricity, broadband, gas. The UK is experiencing high energy costs and it may be beneficial to compare prices with other suppliers. [Ofgem guide to switching energy suppliers](#) is a site to find out more. If you are on certain benefits then you may be entitled to discounted services, such as [broadband social tariffs](#).

2. Shopping online/price comparison sites. It is possible to save lots of money if you shop online instead of on the High Street.
