- A Gmail account.

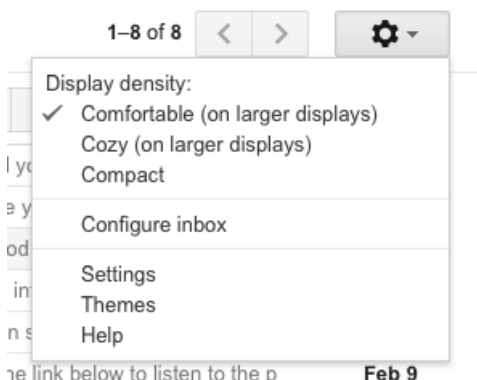
Follow these step-by-step instructions to change your Gmail password

Step 1: Open your web browser and go to www.gmail.com.

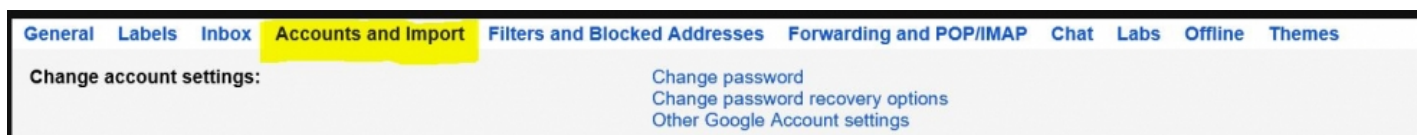
Step 2: Enter your Gmail email address and password in the log in fields. Then press **Sign in**.

Step 3: You will now be taken to your main Gmail inbox.

Step 4: Click on the 'cog' icon in the top right hand corner. Choose **Settings**, and then select **See All Settings**.



Step 5: You will now be shown the 'General settings' options. The option to change password is in a different settings menu. Click on **Accounts and Import** along the top.



Step 6: Choose **Change password**.

Gmail will ask you to verify your account. To change your password you will have to enter your old password and then click **Next**.
