

How to check your credit score online

Lenders look at your credit score when they decide whether to give you a loan, mortgage or credit card. Every time you apply for credit or a loan, that request is recorded. It's a good idea to check your credit score to ensure it's up to date and reflects your credit track record accurately.

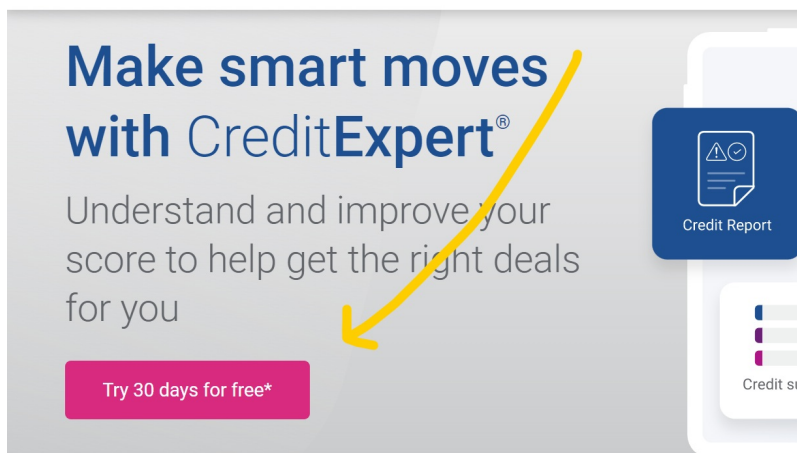

You'll need:



Follow these steps to check your credit score online

Step 1: Go the CreditExpert website (www.creditexpert.co.uk) and click **Get your FREE Experian Credit Report & Score**.



Step 5: On the next page, select the bank your current account and your credit card is with using the drop down menus next to each question and click on the blue **Continue** button.

To see your credit report now we need to do some further checks to confirm your identity. This is to help protect your information and ensure only you get access to your Experian Credit Report and Score.

1 Which bank is your current account with?

A current account is an account with a bank or similar organisation enabling payments to be made or received. Often comes with a debit card, chequebook and overdraft facility.

2 Who do you have a credit card with?

Does not include Charge Cards. (Charge Cards allow you to pay for goods and services on credit, but with a charge card you must pay off your balance in full at the end of the month. These are often store cards).

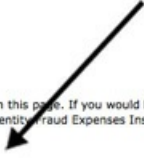

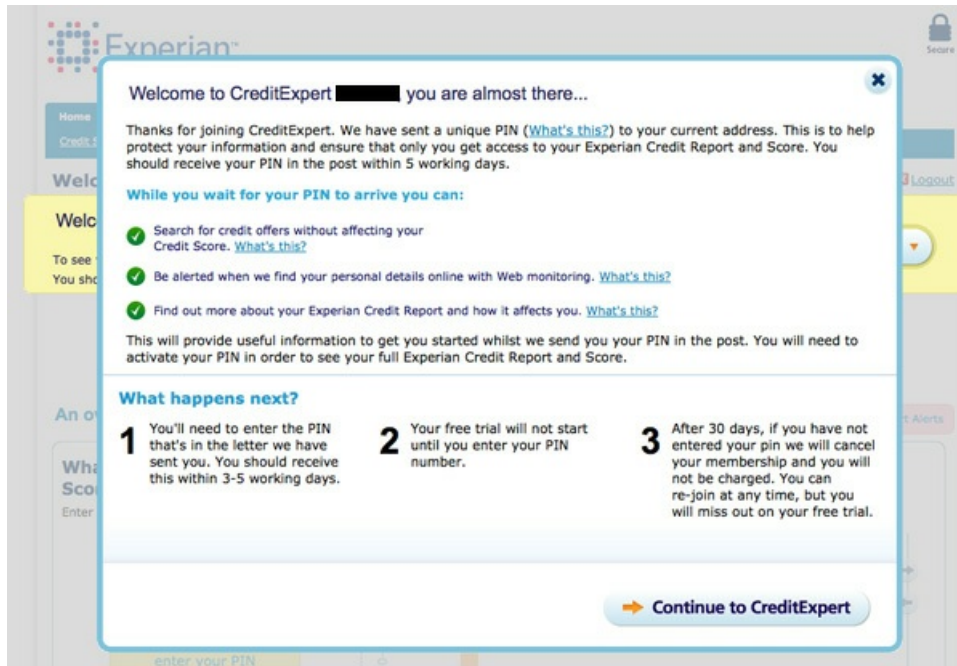

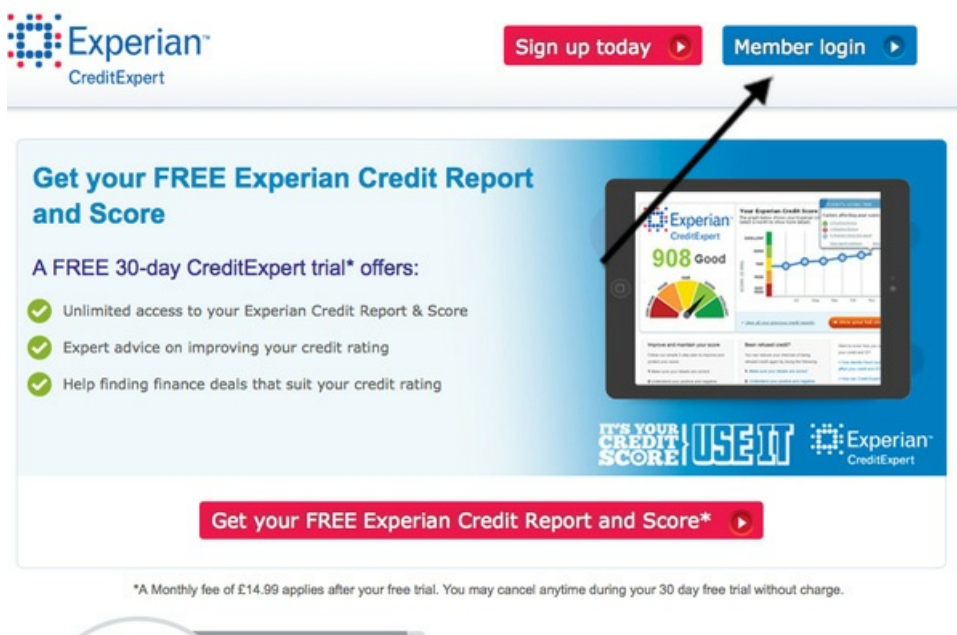

Step 7: A new 'Welcome' page will open explaining that you will be sent a PIN (your own unique reference number) in the post within five working days, which you will need before you can access your credit score.



Step 8: Once you have received your PIN, go back to the CreditExpert website and click on the blue **Member login** button.



Step 9: A new page will open asking for your login details. Fill out your username and password, and then click on the blue **Next** button.

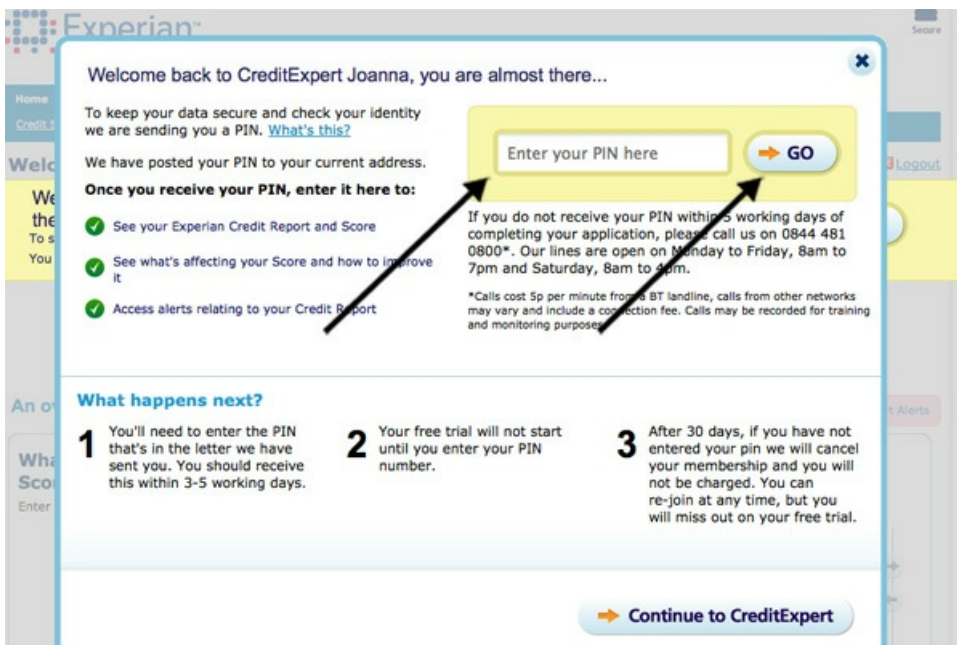
