

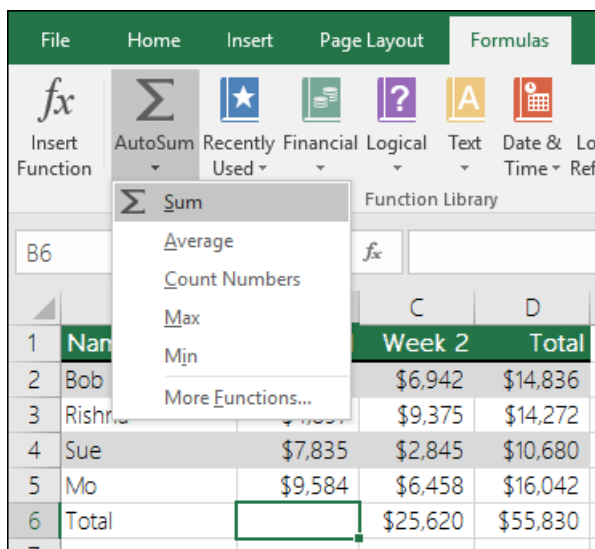
# How to do a sum in Excel
