Link shortening is the practise of reducing the length of website <u>URLs</u> to fit in a limited space. Largely made popular with the expansion of Twitter due to the microblogging site's restrictive 140 characters per post limit, short URLs are becoming more and more common. While <u>bit.ly</u> was the most popular service used, Twitter's <u>http://t.co</u> address is becoming more prevalent on the social network.
